What should I know already?	What will I know by the end of the unit?
EYFS- Identify people they know who look after them and keep them safe- eg, parents, relatives, teacher	<ul> <li>That people have different roles in the community to help them (and others) keep safe - the jobs they do and how they help people</li> <li>Who can help them in different places and situations; how to attract someone's attention or ask for help; what to say</li> <li>How to respond safely to adults they don't know</li> <li>What to do if they feel unsafe or worried for themselves or others; and the importance of keeping on asking for support until they are heard</li> <li>How to get help if there is an accident and someone is hurt, including how to dial 999 in an emergency and what to say</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>I can identify people who help keep me safe- parents, relatives,</li> <li>I can identify people in my community who keep me safe- teachers, police, ambulance, paramedic, firefighters, lifeguards, mountain rescue</li> <li>I know when and how to dial 999 in an emergency and what to say</li> <li>I can recognise the potential for danger from adults I don't know and what to do about it- don't go with them, run away, shout, run into a safe building like a shop or a busy place, find an adult in uniform (like in a shop tell someone what happened)</li> </ul>

Roles	Eg: firefighter, paramedic, police officer, lifeguard etc					
Community	A group of people living in the same place or having particular things in common.					
Accident	An unfortunate incident that happens unexpectedly and results in damage or injury.					
Emergency	A serious, unexpected, and often dangerous situation requiring immediate action.					
Safe	Protected from or not exposed to danger or risk.					

Respond	Do something as a reaction to someone or something.
Stranger	A person you don't not know.
