Attached is a 'Look what I can do at home' sheet. This has lots of spaces for you to record your child's achievements at home. There is no given timescale for completing one of these, simply hand it to a teacher when it is full and we will replace it with a blank one. The sheets will be added to your child's learning journal as part of the ongoing record of their year in Class R.

This is designed to enable us to build up a more complete picture of your child and to provide you as parents with opportunities too feed back to us achievements in your child's learning.

You may wish to tell share with us any achievements or steps in your child's development and I hope that eventually your child will begin to tell you what they would like to be noted. Here are some examples;

- I helped to write a shopping list by sounding out some of the words.
- I wrote my name for the first time with the letters in the right order.
- I recognised the word 'big' in my book, on a sign or a packet.
- I counted 10 spoons when I helped with the washing up.
- I sang a song from our Christmas play.
- I made a model of a house out of junk.
- I swam without my arm bands for the first time.
- I did my buttons all by myself.
