<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How to create a picture using paint, holding and using a variety of painting tools and other equipment correctly</li> <li>• How to use paint and equipment in a variety of ways to create different effects such as dots and lines</li> <li>• How to create pictures with texture using rubbings and tearing paper</li> <li>• How to create a drawing using different lines and shapes</li> <li>• How to create a sculpture using clay</li> <li>• To be able to talk about my work and the work of other artists, expressing likes and dislikes</li> </ul>	<p><b>Drawing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use sketchbooks to collect and record information, famous artwork, annotations and drawn ideas.</li> <li>• Draw for a sustained amount of time at own level</li> <li>• <b>Line</b>- experiment with different grades of pencil and other implements to create lines and marks</li> <li>• <b>Tone</b>- apply different tones by drawing in a different way</li> <li>• <b>Texture</b>- apply simple use of pattern and texture in drawings</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Painting</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experiment with different effects and textures</li> <li>• Mix colours to create own desired colours using more specific colour language e.g. hue, tint, tone, shade</li> <li>• Show increasing independence and creativity with the painting process</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Sculpture</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plan, design and make models from observation and own imagination</li> <li>• Join clay with increasing accuracy and construct a simple base for extending and modelling</li> <li>• Create surface pattern and texture in a variety of malleable materials using a range of tools</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Artists</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Find out about the work of different artists, craft-makers and designers</li> <li>• Make links to own artwork</li> <li>• Investigate different cultures</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Evaluation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Evaluate my work and that of other artists using the language of art, craft and design</li> </ul>
