Inanimate	A motionless object or image.			
CGI	Computer Generated Imagery.			
Stop-Motion	A technique whereby the camera is repeatedly stopped and started, for example to give animated figures the impression of movement.			
Video Clip	A short piece of film or animation.			
Onion Skinning	A technique used in creating animated cartoons and editing movies to see multiple frames at once.			
Frame	An individual pictures in a sequence of images.			
Sound	Music or verbal effects that can be added to the animation.
